in the case for peace dershowitz identifies twelve geopolitical barriers to peace between israel and palestine and explains how to move around them and push the process forward from the division of jerusalem and israeli counterterrorism measures to the security fence and the iranian nuclear threat his analyses are clear headed well argued and sure to be controversial according to dershowitz achieving a lasting peace will require more than tough minded negotiations between israelis and palestinians in academia europe the un and the arab world israel bashing and anti-semitism have reached new heights despite the recent israeli palestinian movement toward peace surveying this outpouring of vilification dershowitz deconstructs the smear tactics used by israel haters and shows how this kind of anti-israel McCarthyism is aimed at scuttling any real chance of peace

the recent rise of antisemitism in the united states has been well documented and linked to groups and ideologies associated with the far right in from occupation to occupy sina arnold argues that antisemitism can also be found as an invisible prejudice on the left based on participation in left wing events and demonstrations interviews with activists and analysis of left wing social movement literature arnold argues that a pattern for enabling antisemitism exists although open antisemitism on the left is very rare there are recurring instances of antisemitic trivialization in which antisemitism is not perceived as a relevant issue in its own right leading to a lack of empathy for jewish concerns and grievances arnold's research also reveals a pervasive defensiveness against accusations of antisemitism in left wing politics with activists fiercely dismissing the possibility of prejudice against jews within their movements and invariably shifting discussions to critiques of israel or other forms of racism from occupation to occupy offers potential remedies for this situation and suggests that a progressive political movement that takes antisemitism seriously can be a powerful force for change in the united states

renton traces the rise of european fascism in the inter war years and focuses on the condition of weimar germany british fascism and hitler's early career

this volume corrects the historical record of anti-semitism revealing recent scholarly consensus on the hottest issues of the israel palestine conflict especially human rights

free of the trauma of northern ireland s civil war finally redeeming himself by questioning some of his own assumptions and then dedicating himself to achieving peace in the good friday peace agreement of 1998 this is a definitive book about personal struggle against traumatic memory but also about how trauma bonding operates in society it is the author s belief that unresolved feelings of psychological trauma are the wheelhouse of systemic evil whether of the dictator the demagogue or the criminal psychopath it is by manipulating shared traumatic memories that tyrants control people and get them to do terrible things they would never otherwise do

before 1967 israel had the overwhelming support of world opinion so long as israel s existence was in harmony with politically correct assumptions it was supported or at least accepted by the majority of progressive jews especially in the wake of the holocaust this is no longer the case the jewish divide over israel explains the role played by prominent jews in turning israel into an isolated pariah nation after their catastrophic defeat in 1967 arabs overcame inferiority on the battlefield with superiority in the war of ideas their propaganda stopped trumpeting their desire to eradicate israel instead in a calculated appeal to liberals and radicals they redefined their war of aggression against the jews as a struggle for the liberation of palestinian arabs the tenacity of arabs rejection of israel and their relentless campaign in schools universities churches professional organizations and above all the news media to destroy israel s moral image had the desired impact many jewish liberals became desperate to escape from the shadow of israel s alleged misdeeds and found a way to do so by joining other members of the left in blaming israeli sins for arab violence today jewish liberals rationalize violence against the innocent as resistance to the oppressor excuse arab extremism as the frustration of a wronged party and redefine eliminationist rhetoric and physical assaults on jews as criticism of israeli policy israel s jewish accusers have played a crucial and disproportionate role in the current upsurge of antisemitism precisely because they speak as jews the essays in this book seek to understand and throw back the assault on israel led by such jewish liberals and radicals as tony judt noam chomsky george steiner daniel boyarin marc ellis israel shahak and many others its writers demonstrate that the foundation of the state of israel far from being the primal sin alleged by its accusers was one of the few redeeming events in a century of blood and shame
